## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–10 OFFERED BY MR. PAPPAS OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

At the end of subtitle B of title XII, add the following:

1 SEC. . REQUESTING AN ASSESSMENT OF END-USE MONI-2 **TORING REGARDING TURKEY'S DEPLOYMENT** 3 OF F-16S TO AZERBAIJAN DURING THE 2020 4 NAGORNO-KARABAKH WAR. 5 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-6 ings: — (1) On September 27, 2020, Azerbaijan, with 7 8 support from Turkey and foreign militia groups, 9 launched a military assault on Nagorno-Karabakh, 10 resulting in the deaths of thousands and displacing 11 tens of thousands of ethnic Armenian residents. 12 (2) A New York Times inquiry discovered 13 Turkish F-16s located at Ganja Airport in Azer-14 baijan on October 3, 2020, while active hostilities 15 between Azerbaijan and Armenia were ongoing. 16 (3) According to the Armenian Ministry of For-17 eign Affairs, Turkish F-16s allegedly violated Arme-18 nian air space during the early days of the conflict.  $\mathbf{2}$ 

(4) On September 29, 2020, it was reported by
 the Armenian Ministry of Defense that a Turkish F 16 was responsible for shooting down an Armenian
 SU-25.

5 (5) It was reported by the Armenian Defense
6 Forces that Turkish F-16s were involved in the co7 ordination of Azerbaijani air force operations, in8 cluding the operation of and in providing Azerbaijani
9 military air support and cover.

10 (b) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the 11 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of De-12 fense, in coordination with the Office of the Director of 13 National Intelligence, shall submit to the appropriate con-14 gressional committees a report concerning the end-use 15 monitoring of Turkish F-16s to Azerbaijan—

16 (1) to determine the nature of the deployment
17 of Turkish-operated F-16s in Azerbaijan, including
18 any role Turkish-operated F-16s played in coordi19 nating with Azerbaijani air force to support military
20 operations;

(2) to include an investigation into allegations
that Turkish-operated F-16s violated sovereign Armenian airspace, and whether these F-16s were deployed in an offensive capacity against the Republic
of Armenia; and

(3) to determine whether the deployment and/ 1 2 or operation of Turkish-operated F-16s in Azer-3 baijan is consistent with end-use agreements, and whether it constitutes misuse or unauthorized use of 4 5 equipment 6 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-7 sional committees" means-8 9 (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the 10 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate; and 11 (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-12

13 resentatives.
