SYNOPSIS: WHEREAS, April 24, 1995, the Eightieth Anniversary of the **Armenian** Genocide of 1915-1923, should be declared a Day of Remembrance; and

TEXT: WHEREAS, April 24, 1995, the Eightieth Anniversary of the **Armenian** Genocide of 1915-1923, should be declared a Day of Remembrance; and

WHEREAS, Such a day would honor the 1,500,000 people of **Armenian** ancestry who were victims of the genocide perpetrated by the governments of the Ottoman Empire from 1915 to 1923, prior to the establishment of the Republic of Turkey; and

WHEREAS, This date is commemorated by all Americans and their friends throughout the world; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we request Governor Jim Edgar to proclaim the Eightieth Anniversary on April 24, 1995 a Day of Remembrance of the **Armenian** Genocide of 1915-1923; and be it further
