Genocide despite the attempt to annihilate them; and

WHEREAS, former Washington Governor Booth Garner proclaimed

April 24th, 1990 as a "Day of Remembrance" in recognition of the 75th anniversary of the Armenian

Genocide; and

WHEREAS, April 24, 2015 will mark the centennial anniversary of the

Armenian Genocide; and

WHEREAS, the Armenian community in Seattle and throughout the

world will remember those who suffered in this terrible

atrocity; and

WHEREAS, every person should be made aware and educated about the

Armenian Genocide and other crimes against humanity.
